



SADDLE LANE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT

As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance service and reliability to our customers, a WSSC project is coming to your neighborhood. It's all part of our commitment to strategically replace and rehabilitate the more than 11,000 miles of aging water and sewer mains buried throughout the WSSC service area.

As we get closer to construction, we are planning to hold a community meeting where we will provide you with more details. In the meantime, please read this letter as it contains important information about this upcoming project.

Scope of Work

- WSSC will be replacing/rehabilitating 2.6 miles of 4", 8", and 12" water mains with new zinc-coated ductile iron pipe, which is expected to last at least 100 years.
- The current water mains were installed in the 1960s and 1970s, and are nearing the end of their life cycle.
- WSSC will replace the portion of the water service line between our water main and the property line connection.
- **Directly Impacted Streets in Potomac Include:** Wandering Trail Drive, Missionwood Way, Lamp Post Lane, Paddock Lane, Stallion Court, North Commons Way, Saddle Lane, Lincolnshire Drive, Deep Spring Drive, Cold Spring Drive, Falls Chapel Way and Huntsman Way.

Estimated Project Schedule*

- Design completion: Winter 2017
- Estimated construction start: Fall 2018
- Estimated construction duration: 1 year and 6 months
- Anticipated work hours: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

***The estimated project schedule may change based on issuance of permits, contracts or inclement weather.**

Additional Information

- Your water service may be interrupted for a few hours while the new main is being connected. Residents will receive a 48-hour advance notification for planned service interruptions.
- A 48-hour advance notification will be distributed in the event of any parking restrictions and changes in work hours.
- Some trees may have to be pruned or removed to accommodate the work. Residents will be notified prior to construction if there is a need for any tree removal. All tree removal and pruning will be supervised by a WSSC urban forester.
- WSSC will restore sidewalks, roadways and landscaping within 90 days of construction completion.
Projects completed during the winter months will be restored the following spring.
